Chapter 8 – Summary of Recommendations

This chapter provides a listing of summarized recommendations. The successful outcome for many of the recommendations will require action by one or more colleges and/or agencies. The entities that should be involved in the implementation of each recommendation are identified.

Recommendations for the Los Rios Community College District found in Chapter 6 are not summarized in this chapter. Those recommendations explicitly state which, if any, agencies outside of the District should be involved in the implementation.

The chapter is divided into five main sections. The first section contains recommendations that are common to American River College, Cosumnes River College, and Sacramento City College. The second through fifth sections contain recommendations that are specific to the individual colleges – ARC, CRC, Folsom Lake College, and SCC.

Recommendations in each section are listed in roughly the same order as they are presented in the *Findings and Recommendations* chapters. The checklist does not prioritize the recommendations.
