

# Safety Signs "I Spy" Activity

How many safety signs can you spot on your walk or ride? Check the boxes below.



## Stop

Stop signs tell cyclists, pedestrians, and drivers to come to a complete stop and wait until it is safe to go.



## Bicycle Crossing

Bicycle Crossing signs tell drivers to expect cyclists entering or exiting the road.



## Pedestrian Crossing

Pedestrian Crossing signs tell drivers and cyclists to expect people crossing the street up ahead.



## Railroad Crossing

Railroad Crossing signs alert people to railroad tracks ahead. These signs are often accompanied by flashing lights and other warning signals when a train is approaching or passing.



## One Way

One Way signs tell drivers and cyclists they can only travel in the direction the arrow is pointing.



## Walk Signal

At crosswalks, when the white hand turns on, you may begin crossing. If the white hand is flashing, you may not begin crossing if you haven't already started. If the hand is red, you may not cross.
